



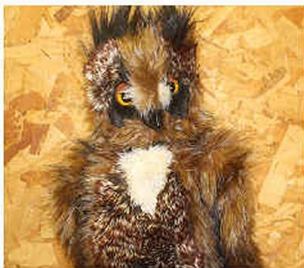

OBJECTIVES AND LOGISTICS

Educational Objectives

- To define bullying.
- To demonstrate that getting angry and being mean isn't the way to stop bullying.
- To model an assertive stance and slogan.
- To show that it is important to tell an adult if the bullying is serious.
- To encourage students to tell an adult if their efforts to stop bullying don't work.
- To show how to stand up for children who are being bullied.
- To differentiate between tattling and reporting.

Pricing & Logistics

The performance is about 40 minutes long. We can see up to 350 students per performance. The space should be at least 10' tall, 16' wide, and 20' deep. CLIMB provides all technical requirements, including sound, set, and costumes.

Pricing is \$660 per performance, plus travel.
