

NO-SEW DRAGON WINGS!

This is how we made the dragon wings in our lesson Drake the Dragon! Make your own and be sure to post it on our Facebook page!

1. Choose your fabric!
 - We suggest fleece, as it does not unravel and washes very well!
2. Collect your supplies!
 - $\frac{3}{4}$ - 1 yard of fleece fabric, 60 inches wide
 - Chalk or washable fabric marker
 - Scissors
 - Salad plate (approx. 7 inches in diameter)
 - Yardstick or tape measure
3. Measure the wingspan of the wing wearer from backbone to fingertip. Then add two inches.
4. Measure the back length of your wing wearer from collar to waistband.
5. Fold your fleece in half which the fold on your right.



6. Measure and mark the back length vertically on your fabric with chalk.



7. Trim fleece to size. DO NOT cut fold.



8. Using the salad plate as your guide, trace a dragon wing shape on your fleece.



9. Cut out your wings. Mark two horizontal armholes approximately 8 and 12 inches from the center of the wing. These should be about 2 inches from the top of the wing. Mark a finger hole about 1 inch from the edge of the wingtip.



10. Cut armholes and finger holes through both layers of the wings. Put your arms through and you're done!
